
# Ash

### **AUTUMN 1 NEWSLETTER 2024**





Recall of the 3, 4, 8 and 50 times tables (as well as the 2, 5 and 10 times tables covered in Year 1 and 2) is important. Children will be given access to Times Tables Rock Stars to use at home.
