Online safety is without doubt one of the most concerning aspects of safeguarding children's well being.

Please be vigilant around your child's use of online gaming and social media.

Many apps popular with children and young people have age guidance and parental control options.

Talking to children regularly about online conduct and safety is invaluable as is restricting time spent online to keep within healthy limits.

At school we dedicate a lesson to online safety at the beginning and end of every half term.

Homework in Year 4.

English or Maths task (30 minutes weekly).

Homework will be either a Maths or English task, set each Monday, to be brought in the following Friday. Children should spend no more than 30 mins completing this. There is a 30 minute homework club on Friday lunchtimes.

Read with your child (20 minutes daily).

Please make sure that you login and record your child's reading daily using the BoomReader app or online at https://boomreader.co.uk/. Individual login details for your child have been provided.

Practise their weekly spellings (10 minutes daily).

Every Monday, we learn our new weekly spellings. We have a test each Friday and children can use their individual logins on Spelling Shed to practise at home.

Practise their times tables (10 minutes daily).

Recall of the 2, 3, 4, 5, 8 and 10 times tables (from Year 3) is important as well as building fluency in 6, 7, 9, 11 and 12 times tables going forward. Children will be given access to Times Tables Rock Stars to use at home. Songs are also a popular way of securing these facts, links are on the class page on the school website.
